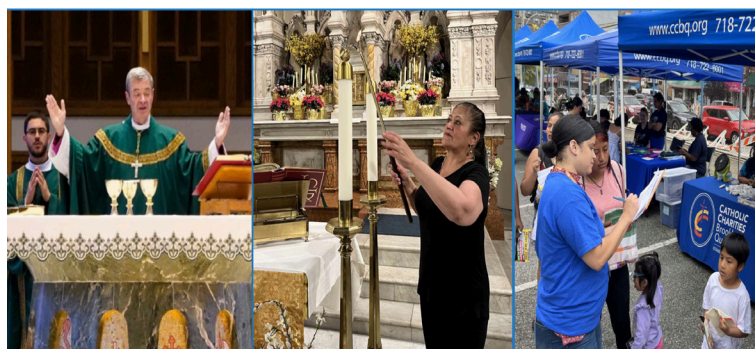
## ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL 2024

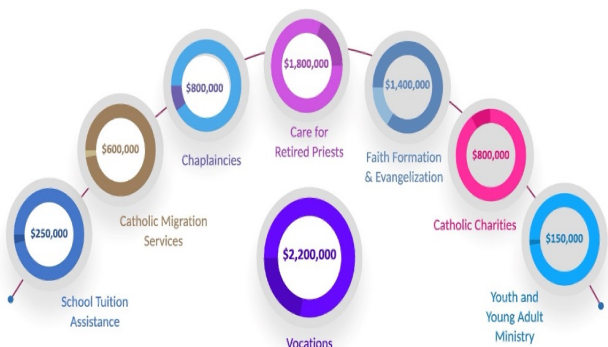


**Q: What do the contributions from the Annual Catholic Appeal support?**

A communal celebration of this sacrament will be scheduled twice a year.
